Keeping Your Photographs Alive Through Metadata

You may spend a lifetime taking photographs and documenting the people, places, and things around you, but what happens to your work when you are gone? Will your relatives and descendants know who, what, when, where, and why you took that image? In this presentation Heather Potter will give an overview of why descriptive metadata is important to help you organize, maintain, and preserve your collection for future users.

Heather Potter is the Curator of Photographs at The Filson Historical Society. In the past she was a Project Archivist at the Kentucky Historical Society. She received her BA in History from Washburn University, Topeka, Kansas, and Master's of Library Science with an emphasis in Archives from Indiana University – Bloomington.

Amateur Digital submission (Your number code should start with "M." (i.e. - M-001-111519-0118-Lovely Photo)

ADVANCED LEVEL

Advanced Color Print

Advanced Monochrome Print

Advanced Digital Submission (Your number code should start with "A." (i.e. - A-001-111519-0118-Pretty Photo)

You MUST compete at the advanced level if:

- > You are a professional photographer (you earn >50% of you annual income from photography.)
 - >You have had a Juried Gallery Showing
- >You have been an LPS Point Plaque winner (excluding Novice) for the last 3 years. (For 2018, this includes Kevin Turner, Chris Hayden Greg Miller, Al Wollerton, George Sherrard, Ken Tripp, Debbie Brownstein, Kay Sherrard, Steve Cowherd, John Holthaus, Gertrude Hudson, and David Becker.)
- >If you are an accomplished photographer and are not in the above groups, you are encouraged to enter at this level.
 - >Anyone else who wants to can compete at this level.

Once you enter at the Advanced Level, you must stay at this level for the rest of the year.

All other members will compete at the Amateur Level.

Year-end plaques will be awarded at all six levels.

All Divisions are limited to two entries each month, for a total of 6 entries per night per person. (i.e. 2 Amateur color print, plus 2 Amateur monochrome prints, plus 2 Amateur digitals OR 2 Advanced color print, plus 2 Advanced monochrome prints, plus 2 Advanced digitals.)
