Normal editions should return starting next month.

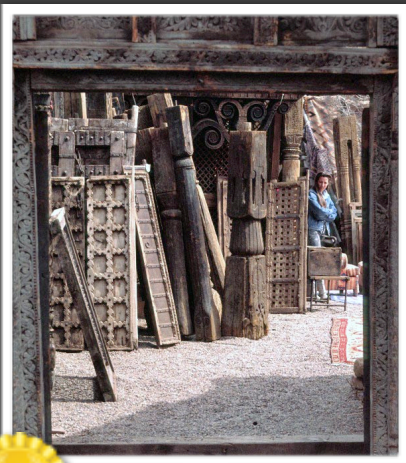

Submit your Best Shot Digital Image for the November meeting.

Due to some technical difficulties at the September meeting, we will show your Best Shot entries at the October meeting instead as well as any new entries submitted since. As we have mentioned before there will be one entry per month per member, and it is open to all members.

This is not a contest but a way for members to share something they are proud of and to provide a way to share images that might not fit a particular category -- so it is wide open. The photo can be from any time but should be your original work, color, B&W, manipulated or whatever. If you elect, your name can be mentioned when the image is shown.

Remember though that the submission guidelines for the monthly digital contest are different than Your Best Shot Digital Image. **Your "Best Shot" Digital Image is due for November by October 31st.**
