
Upcoming LPS Meeting at Outdoor Photo Gear

Dr T.Y. Huang to present at May 8th Meeting

Our own LPS member T.Y. Huang will be presenting to the Louisville Photographic Society at the May 8th meeting at Outdoor Photo Gear. His topic will be "Hummingbird Photography. If anyone has tried to photograph a hummingbird will know, this is a difficult venture most times.

Dr T.Y. Huang, known to his friends as T.Y., is a professor of radiology at the University of Louisville School of Medicine. He graduated from medical school in 1966. After two years of mandatory military service in Taiwan, he completed four years of radiology residency training in Taiwan. After his residency. T.Y. Practiced and taught radiology in Tri-service General Hospital Taipei, Taiwan, where he fell in love with photography.

Dr Huang moved to Louisville in 1976 where he repeated his radiology residency and fellowship training and then joined the Department of Radiology at the University of Louisville School of Medicine in 1979. He retired from medical school in 2011.

Because of his radiology background, he developed a good sense of close up and still life photography. He has enjoyed both travel and scenic photography. T.Y says "He travels around the world with his two lovers. Mary, his wife,



takes care of everything, and he carries his second lover, the camera bag, on his back."



In his leisure time. he likes hiking and outdoor activities with nature and wildlife photography are his favorite subjects.

T.Y joined LPS in 1999. He has been a frequent winner in photo contests. In 2003, a photo of Locust Grove won the Louisville Historical League's "A Focus on Our Heritage" photo contest with the image adorning the cover of the league's 2004 calendar. He has also won first place and finalist in the Courier Journal Travel photo contests in 2006 and 2007.

He has won several ribbons at the Kentucky State Fair and several plaques at LPS.


