"Remember Street Photography is a category this year. Leave your tripod at home (I can't believe I said that). Be prepared for daylight and nightlife conditions (flash will be helpful). I prefer to challenge myself with short prime lens (20mm, 50mm or 60mm) for this kind of shooting but but any zoom (28mm-135mm) for example will



work also. It's sometimes good to work in group's, your subject may be looking at your fellow photographer trying to figure out what they a shooting as you capture their candid image. BE POLITE AND RESPECTFUL AND PROMOTE LPS WHEN YOU CAN!"
