A Note from Al Boice "Make it Stick" when mounting your prints!

In an effort to make sure your images are presented and viewed correctly, Al Boice would like to remind you to make sure you tape your mounts sufficiently when mounting your prints and attaching the mat board to the mounting board. Many times the prints will fall out when being handled, or the mat board flips up uncovering the mounted print.

As you know the winning images are displayed at the Episcopal Church Retirement Home. So assume you are going to win and make sure you securely mount all three elements securely for each submitted print.

The guidelines of the 2014 Book of the Year Award are as follows:

- 1. All images shall be images shot in 2013 or later.
- 2. The book must be printed after December 1, 2013 and before the December 2014 LPS meeting.
- 3. The book can be any size with no limit on dimensions or number of pages.
- 4. The book can be any subject matter.
- 5. Each member can submit one book per year for judging.
- 6. The book will be judged at the end of 2014 and awarded in February 2015.

The submitted book will be judged on overall content quality including photography, layout and editing. Later in 2014 we plan to offer a workshop or presentation on how and where to print your own book. We plan on having members who have printed books to bring in samples to show LPS members what can be accomplished online.

Reminders when submitting digital files.

When to submit digital images

- 1.Digital submissions must be submitted at least two weeks before the meeting when they are to be judged.
- 2. They may be brought to the the month before, or emailed to DigEntries@louisvillephotographic.org
- 3. Entries not received by the deadline, (two weeks before the meeting at midnight) will not be accepted.
- 4. Be sure to add the digital images to your entry form and bring to the monthly meeting.

Remember the following when submitting digital images.

The great thing about submitting digital images for competition is that you do not have to go through the extra steps of printing and matting your images. The downside of course, is that you have to submit the image for judging two weeks before the final judging. **Be sure to double check your files before you submit**.

Maximum Dimensions

- 1. Images must not exceed **1024 pixels** on the longest side. They may be smaller however.
- 2. Keep in mind, images shown with the long dimension as a vertical photo, will be somewhat smaller on a digital slideshow.

Resolution

The image file must not exceed 120 ppi and must not exceed 1 MB per image entered.

Format

File must be in the JPEG (.JPG) format. No other formats will be accepted for entry.


Determining the Dimensions and Resolution in Photoshop and Lightroom


File Naming for Digital Submissions

Digital submissions must be named as follows.

- A. Use a three digit number signifying whether it is your first or second submission for the competition, (001 or 002)
- B. Use a hyphen, dash or minus sign.

C. Insert a Six Digit number that corresponds to your first, middle and last initials. (A=01 and Z=26). If you do not have a middle name, use number "00".

- D. Use another hyphen, dash or minus sign
- E. Insert a Four Digit number indicating the month and year of the competition. (mmyy)
- F. Use a hyphen, dash or minus sign
- G. Add a short name of the image name, with no spaces in the name.



Submission Example

<u>Kay Gertrude Wollerton submitted two digital images</u>, with the <u>second</u> image called "<u>Swan Afloat</u> " for a <u>September 2014</u> competition.

Using the submission guidelines, the submission file name would be:

002-110723-0914-SWANAFLOAT

About the Louisville Photographic Society

Membership in LPS is open to everyone. You must be a member of LPS to submit photos for competition. The areas of competition are Color Prints, Monochrome and Digital submissions. No more than 6 entries may be submitted, with no more then 2 entries in each group.

A Novice Division has been created for people just entering photography. People entering the Novice Division may not also enter any of the above groups except Digital submissions, where they may submit two photos. Members of the Novice group may submit a total of three prints. The prints may be in color or monochrome. See the LPS website for complete rules, www.louisvillephotographic.org Digitals entries must be sent to digentries@louisvillephotographic.org, and must be received two weeks before the meeting.
