This month's meeting is one of those nights and will prove to be one of the best and most enjoyable evenings of photography.

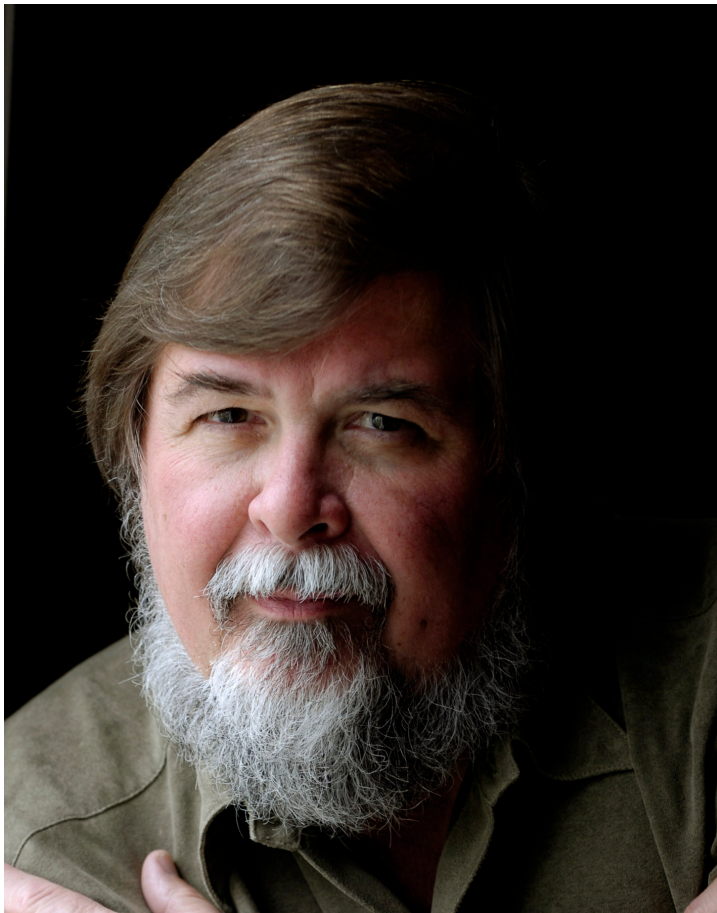
During the meeting, Bill will show how to improve your ability to see photographs, in terms of light, form, design, and color and organize those elements into images that have real impact.

Bill Fortney, with 45 years experience, has incredible experience as a newspaper and magazine photojournalist and sports photographer. For the past twenty years, he has been one of the leading nature photographers. He founded the Great American Photography Workshop company, putting on workshops throughout the US.

His best selling books include; **"The Nature of America"**, **"America from 500 Feet"**, **"American Vision"**, **"Bill Fortney's Great Photography Workshop"** as well as **"Getting Serious About Outdoor Photography"**.

**"America from 500 Feet"** was one of the largest selling aviation photograph books of all time.

Bill has also been named a Fellow by the North American Nature Photographer's Association./



He retired in 2013 as a Nikon Professional Services technical representative for the last 11 years.

Bill now runs his own workshops under the company name, "His Light Workshops".

He also teaches for KelbyOne and appears at Photoshop World as a speaker and presenter.

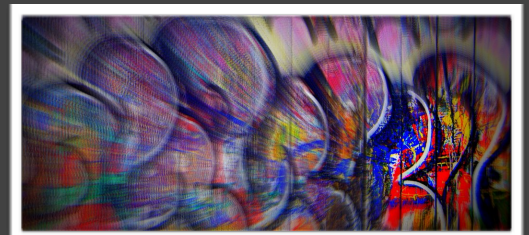

The guidelines of the 2014 Book of the Year Award are as follows:

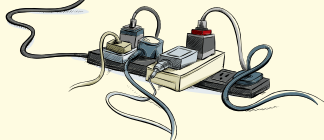
1. All images shall be images shot in 2013 or later.
2. The book must be printed after December 1, 2013 and before the December 2014 LPS meeting.
3. The book can be any size with no limit on dimensions or number of pages.
4. The book can be any subject matter.
5. Each member can submit one book per year for judging.
6. The book will be judged at the end of 2014 and awarded in February 2015.

The submitted book will be judged on overall content quality including photography, layout and editing. Later in 2014 we plan to offer a workshop or presentation on how and where to print your own book. We plan on having members who have printed books to bring in samples to show LPS members what can be accomplished online.

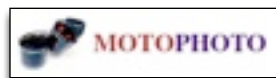

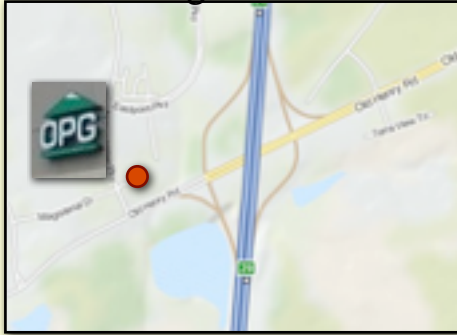
