LPS July 9th Workshop moves to Hidden Hill Nursery on July 27th!

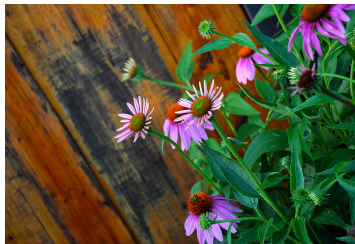
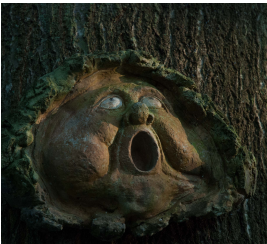
LPS to have early access to photograph this art and nature wonderland in Utica, Indiana

Start your book for Book of the Year Award!

The guidelines of the 2014 Book of the Year Award are as follows:

1. All images shall be images shot in 2013 or later.
2. The book must be printed after December 1, 2013 and before the December 2014 LPS meeting.
3. The book can be any size with no limit on dimensions or number of pages.
4. The book can be any subject matter.
5. Each member can submit one book per year for judging.
6. The book will be judged at the end of 2014 and awarded in February 2015.

The submitted book will be judged on overall content quality including photography, layout and editing. Later in 2014 we plan to offer a workshop or presentation on how and where to print your own book. We plan on having members who have printed books to bring in samples to show LPS members what can be accomplished online.

Don't miss the Ky State Fair deadlines!

The photography competition is a part of "Fine Arts" at the KSF website

-As mentioned in an LPS email, print registration **was July 1, 2014.**

- The **deadline for submitting digital photos** to the Flickr site (applies to the "Theme" classes 63, 73, 83, 93, 103 and 107) is midnight on July 15, 2014. For questions, please see the Premium Book section of the KSF web site, www.kystatefair.org

- Once you've entered, **bring your prints** to the Ky State Fairgrounds on Sat., Aug. 9 (between 10 and 5) or Sun. Aug. 10 (between 12 and 5.)

- **We will need LOTS of help** during that time, because LPS members are responsible for screening entries, checking entries in, and distributing them for hanging. **PLEASE help by volunteering for a few hours Sat August 9 or Sunday August 10.** Contact AIW@louisvillephotographic.org if you can help.

- Remember that the digital entries will not be accepted during that time. They should have been entered on Flickr by the July 15 deadline.

-The **pick-up date for your Fair entries after the Fair is over is Mon., Aug. 25.** If you do not want to pick up your entries, indicate on the back of the entry that the Fair board can dispose of them.

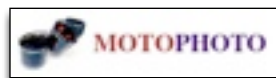
