Three Wheels to Cleveland

The photographic challenges of documenting a 14 day trike ride will be presented by Ken Tripp at the October meeting



Ken Tripp has been involved in photography off and on for over 40 years. He has a wide variety of experience from filming college football and basketball games professionally, photographing weddings and then focusing on nature and wildlife on large format film.

He has been shooting a DSLR since the early days going back 14 years. He has been involved with LPS extensively since his retirement from GE in 2009.

Ken has also been the "LPS Reflexions" newsletter editor for the last 4 years. He brought it from a printed version to the pdf version that you see every month in your email.

As many of you know, Ken left on September 3rd of last month, for an extensive 14 day charity ride on a recumbent trike from Louisville to Cleveland. The charity ride was called Cycling for Parkinsons and has

raised over \$13,000 for the Michael J. Fox Foundation for Parkinsons Research. Ken was the sole trike rider for the ride and his wife Kathy drove their Jeep as the Support and Gear (SAG) vehicle.

Ken's presentation will spotlight the challenges of photographing the ride while actually being part of the ride himself. He will talk about how LPS members can enjoy the Rails to Trails in Ohio and where the best places to photograph may be.







Start Submitting Your 2014 Winning Images at October, November and December Meetings

IMPORTANT: You will need to have all LPS point winning prints, including Honorable Mentions turned in by the December meeting in order to have them judged for the Year End competition. Judging this year will be done at the end of December this year. Do not put this off until January. It will be too late!

Alphabet Slide Show Competition in December



For the fourth year in a row LPS will be having an Alphabet Slide Show Competition. This competition will be in addition to the Boats photo competition at the same meeting. Simply put together any slide show that represents letters of the alphabet.

Any member can submit an automated digital slide presentation on a thumb/flash drive or DVD that can operate on a Windows computer. The slide show should be approximately three minutes in length.

Book of the Year Rules Revised

In order to encourage more LPS members to compete, we have revised the 2014 Book of the Year Award Guidelines:

1. NEW! All images can be shot from any time period instead of just 2013 or later

2. NEW! All images do not have to be photographed by the LPS member. There should be enough original images for the LPS member to be considered and identified as author or editor. Other photos should be credited and added with permission.

- 3. The book must be printed after December 1, 2013 and before the December 2014 LPS meeting.
- 4. The book can be any size with no limit on dimensions or number of pages.
- 5. The book can be any subject matter.
- 6. Each member can submit one book per year for judging.
- 7. The book will be judged at the end of 2014 and awarded in February 2015.

The submitted book will be judged on overall content quality including photography, layout and editing.

Membership in LPS is open to everyone. You must be a member of LPS to submit photos for competition. The areas of competition are Color Prints, Monochrome and Digital submissions. No more than 6 entries may be submitted, with no more then 2 entries in each group.

A Novice Division has been created for people just entering photography. People entering the Novice Division may not also enter any of the above groups except Digital submissions, where they may submit two photos. Members of the Novice group may submit a total of three prints. The prints may be in color or monochrome.
