Theme: Scenic

Scenic photographs covering Landscapes or Cityscapes. We want to see your best shot...

Eligibility: Adult

The competition is open to all photographers both amateur and professional. Entrants must be 18 years of age or older to enter.

Image Presentation:

Mounted Prints Only.

Images may be in color or black and white.

Photograph minimum size 8×10 to maximum 11×14 matted on a 16×20 mount board.

Standard mount board or foam core mounts are acceptable but presentation should not exceed 1/2".

Glass covered or framed entries are not permitted.

Entry Information and Deadline:

Judge(s) reward artistic merit and look for prints demonstrating photographic excellence, high standards of fine art criteria in each image. Photographs entered must be prints of your original captured image

The limit is 2 photographs per person.

Photographs must be entered by 6:00 pm Friday September 20, 2013. Fill out the entry form (*See website listed above for forms*) and make 2 copies. Securely attach a copy to the back of your mount board and turn a copy in with the photograph. You can drop off your entry starting on Wednesday, September 18, 2013. Entries go to Bethel-St. Paul office at 4004 Shelbyville Rd, Wednesday thru Friday. Office hours are between 9am to 4pm. Additional evening hours will be Friday September 23 until 6:00pm.

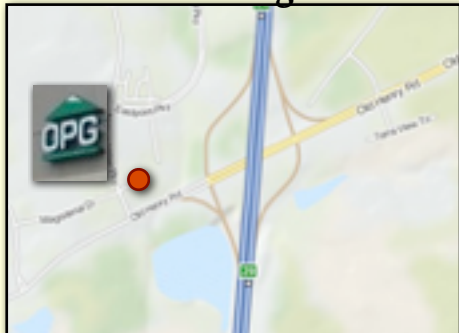
Alphabet Slide Show Competition in December

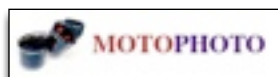
