No more than 6 entries may be submitted, with no more than 2 entries in each group.

You MUST compete at the advanced level if:

- You are a professional photographer (you earn >50% of you annual income from photography.)
- You have had a Juried Gallery Showing
- You have been an LPS Point Plaque winner (excluding Novice) for the last 3 years.
- Anyone else can compete at this level and if you are an accomplished photographer and are not in the above groups, you are encouraged to enter at this level.
