Our theme will be Kentuckiana: the Beauty of Our Home. Our showing will kick off with an opening reception on Saturday, October 5, from 2-4 PM at the library. Photos will be installed by our committee in the week prior and hang at least through the end of the Biennial, November 10. The library has created a brand new space and we will be the first to exhibit in the area. We expect to be able to display over 20 framed prints from our members.

If you would like to participate, we would love to include your work! You must be a current member to take part in the exhibit. We will have a Dropbox account set up following the June meeting for digital submissions to be juried in July. Please be advised, if your image is selected, you will need to have the image printed, matted, and framed, following the LPS guidelines for the exhibit. You must be able to deliver the pick up the artwork at the Clarksville Library. Currently, we are working on a group discount with a local framer on 16x20 black frames.

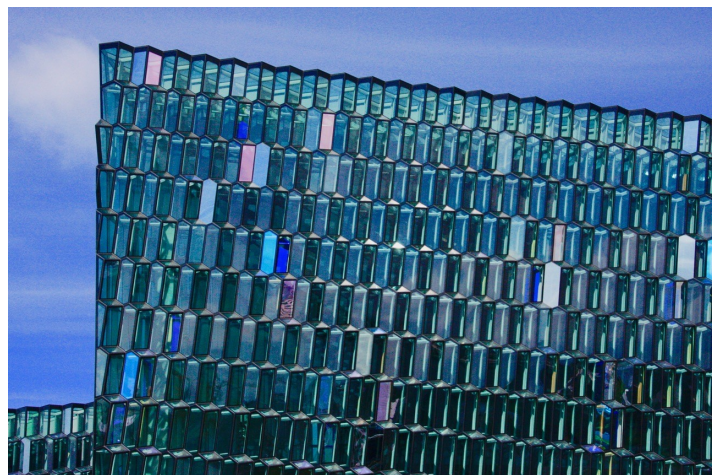

Membership in LPS is open to everyone. You must be a member of LPS to submit photos for competition. There are two levels of competition, Amateur and Advanced, with three categories in each level, Color Prints, Monochrome Prints, and Digital submissions. No more than 6 entries may be submitted, with no more than 2 entries in each group.

You **MUST** compete at the advanced level if:

- You are a professional photographer (you earn >50% of your annual income from photography.)
- You have had a Juried Gallery Showing
- Anyone else can compete at this level and if you are an accomplished photographer and are not in the above groups, you are encouraged to enter at this level.
